**Pattern & Syllabus of Examination :-** The Applicants shall be subjected to an Aptitude Test with a total 100 marks covering the following subjects/ topics. Aptitude Test will be comprising four parts [Part-A, Part-B, Part-C(i), Part-C(ii)]. The total duration of the Aptitude Test will be **2 hours (120 Minutes)**. *There is no negative marking.*

<b>A - General Knowledge</b> (25 marks with 25 questions of 1 mark each)	<b>Topics:</b> Geography, Indian History, Freedom Struggle, Culture & Sports, General Polity & Constitution of India, Economics, General Science, Current Affairs and Reasoning & Analytical ability of 10 <sup>th</sup> standard.
<b>B - Mathematics</b> (25 marks with 25 questions of 1 mark each)	<b>Topics:</b> Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals & Fractions, Relationship between Numbers, Fundamental Arithmetical Operations, Percentages, Ratio & Proportion, Profit & Loss, Simple Interest, Average, Discount, Partnership, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Use of Tables & Graphs, Mensuration
<b>C(i) - English</b> (25 marks with 25 questions of 1 mark each)	<b>Topics:</b> Articles, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Tenses, Verbs, Synonyms & Antonyms, Vocabulary, Sentence Structure, Proverbs, Phrases, Questions from small unseen passage etc.
<b>C(ii) - Regional Language (हिन्दी)</b> (25 marks with 25 questions of 1 mark each)	<b>Topics:</b> शब्द-पद, क्रिया भेद, मिश्र व संयुक्त वाक्य, वाक्यों का रूपान्तरण, स्वर-संधि, अलंकार, समास, मुहावरे एवं लोकोक्तियां, अशुद्ध वाक्य संशोधन, अपठित गद्यांश

**Selection Process :-**

**(A) Minimum Qualifying Marks :-**

The minimum Qualifying Marks to be obtained in each part of Aptitude Test :-

Category	Minimum Qualifying Marks
<b>UR</b>	10 marks in each part & 40 in aggregate
<b>SC/ST</b>	8 marks in each part & 33 in aggregate
<b>OBC</b>	9 marks in each part & 37 in aggregate

The selection will purely on merit basis which will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the Aptitude test separately for each category. It is further stated that if two or more candidates secure equal marks in Aptitude test and they are standing in the last position in the merit list than it is clearly stated that the candidate senior in age will be considered for selection.

**(B) Preparation of merit list :-** A common merit list for the whole Rajasthan Postal Circle shall be prepared in respect of all categories of post put together. For the said purpose candidates shall indicate their preferences of the Post (Postman or Mail Guard) and also indicate 10 preferences of Divisions for Postman and 2 preferences for Mail Guard, while applying online. Thereafter the candidates will be allotted to the posts and the divisions as per their preference based on their position in the merit list and availability of vacancies.

Such candidate, who is not able to get the allocation in any of the Division as per preference because of his/her performance, such candidates might be allocated to the division, where the vacancy exists. The candidates who did not given preference of division during submission of form, it will be presumed that they have equal preference for all the divisions and may be allocated to the division where vacancy exists at the discretion of the competent authority.
